SUBMITTING A PROPOSAL:

Each submission must include the following:

1. A brief overview of the work (including a working title/subtitle; author bio and credentials; category of book)
2. Proposed table of contents and sample chapter(s)
3. Intended audience (demographic; why this book will appeal)
4. Market analysis (existing market; gaps in existing market that your book would fill)
